FALSE ALARM REDUCTION TIPS

False alarms not only negatively impact on your home and personal life, but they also affect your security provider and the community. They can create dissatisfaction with your system, as well as the security provider. Additionally, police resources across the country are limited; thousands of patrol hours are spent investigating alarm reports that turn out to be false. You can take simple steps to reduce false alarms. The first is to identify common causes:

- Using incorrect keypad codes or failing to train authorized users.
- Failure to secure doors and windows once the alarm is turned on.
- Wandering pets or objects hanging by/around motion detectors.
- Re-entering the home just after leaving without disarming the system.
- Low batteries and faulty equipment.

Once the causes are identified, some basic steps should help reduce false alarms:

- Properly train all users (ie: babysitters, relatives, children, homewatch, etc.).
- Secure doors and windows before turning on alarm.
- Inform ADT of changes in emergency contacts and authorized users.
- Service and maintain the system (including batteries) properly.

SECURITY TIPS

- ⇒ If you've just moved into a new home, remember to change all of the locks. And if you'll be out of town, never hide a key outside your home.

- ⇒ Manage landscaping. The most basic measures, such as keeping shrubs trimmed so burglars cannot hide, or planting thorny bushes in front of windows often serve as deterrents for criminals.
